Lead-in What's going to happen here to introduce your students to the topic?

- 1. Europe Map to show on video 1 minute entering in the class
- 2. Then switch off the map on the video
- 3. Divide students in groups -
- 4. Give them white pieces puzzles of EU Country Shapes and let them
- 5. Rebuilt Europe (3 minutes)





What can students predict or do to get started with the lesson? Time 4 minutes

- 4 min Students should discuss in couple to understand the position of the Countries in Europe and they should compose Europe map.

Every couple has Poland. Only Poland is not coloured and on it there is written the name of the country. The other countries are coloured but the name is written only on the smallest countries. The main countries (France, Spain, Italy, Portugal, Ireland, Germany) are shaped and coloured without name.

What vocabulary could teachers focus on? What needs to be pre-taught? Time 4 minutes

3 minutes Teacher can ask each group to share with the one on their left

How did they build Europe

Which are the 6 Countries near Poland?

One of the group will report : How's Poland position in Europe

Teacher will introduce synonims: Central location, Prime location, Heart of Europa, Core position-

Then student can colour just Poland (1 minute) while listening to classical music di Chopin

What kinds of texts can students **listen** to or **read** to deepen their knowledge? Time (8m,23s) + 20 minutes
